

In and Around

Porthtowan is a small village on the North Coast of Cornwall in an area of outstanding natural beauty, and being less than one mile from the Site, it provides a Post Office, Village Store, and Surf shops (including tuition and hire).

The beach is one of the few in Cornwall to be awarded Blue Flag status and offers excellent surfing, as well as a variety of rock pools and coves to explore.

Situated in a former tin-mining area, the restored engine houses and heritage buildings are steeped in local history, many of which are to be found on the Coast-to-Coast Tramway Trail that passes just half a mile from the Site. Together with the Coastal Path and wonderful Gardens in the area, there are plenty of places to walk or cycle.



Eating out on holiday is a must - for the traditional Cream Tea and Pasty or just a snack, there are a number of pubs, restaurants and takeaways all within a short distance.

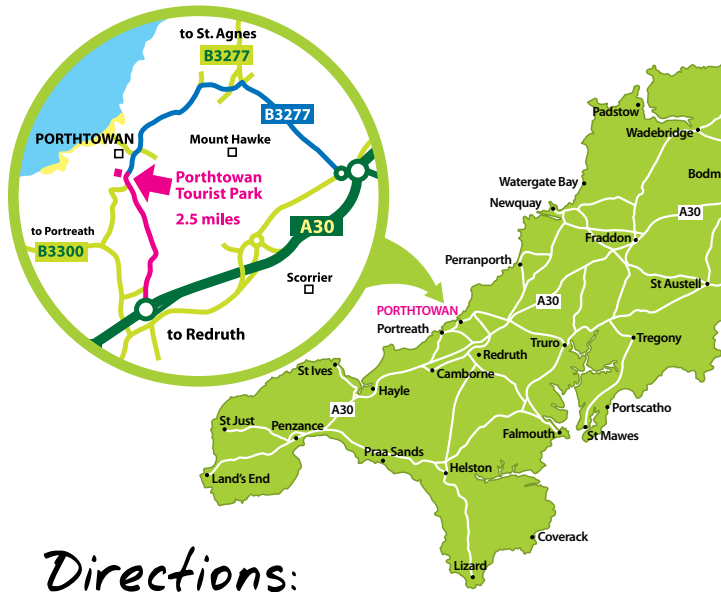

Directions:

■ Chiverton Cross Roundabout

Take the 3rd exit towards St Agnes, then the 3rd exit again at the small roundabout. After one and a half miles turn left at the crossroads by Sevenmilestone garage. Follow the coast road for just over two miles, past the sign for the village and beach and continue up the hill. At the top you will find us on your right just after the small crossroads.

■ Redruth/Porthtowan/Portreath Exit

At the top of the sliproad take the 3rd exit from the roundabout and continue on a winding road for two miles into the valley. Turn right at the T junction and you will find us on your left at the top of the hill. **Ignore SAT NAV directions that try to send you left into a narrow lane!**

On site

Porthtowan Tourist Park is a quiet family run site covering 6 acres, with the 80 marked pitches laid out over three separate fields which are all bordered by a variety of mature trees and Cornish Hedges. Each field is level and landscaped with flower borders, shrubs and hedges to provide some shelter and privacy. There is an electric hookup point for every pitch, most of which are grass but a few are hard-standings. In addition we now have Premium pitches which provide a water and grey waste point as well as the hookup box.

The Site is the ideal place to relax and unwind as there is no bar/clubhouse and the rural location means that you are surrounded by farmland and far enough from any urban glow, perfect for stargazing.

We have tried to think of everything from a spin dryer and iron to a wetsuit rinse and a socket (for hair straighteners).



Environment

We are very pleased to have been awarded Silver in the David Bellamy Conservation Awards. This scheme was set up to recognise the work involved in reducing the impact on the environment and increasing sustainability.

As part of this we try to leave the boundaries and certain areas of grass uncut, as this helps to promote the native plants and encourage the birds and wildlife. The Adventure Playground has been made from sustainable forests and the safety surface is from recycling our own trees. We also provide bird boxes, low level lighting, and sun tubes and encourage our visitors to recycle.
